EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2012-02

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING
THE MAYOR'S FILM AND MUSIC ADVISORY BOARD OF TULSA**

WHEREAS, the film, television, video and music industries are important components of the national and international culture and economy; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa and its environs possess scenic beauty, visual impact, and historic and artistic significance; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Tulsa possess artistic, musical and dramatic ability, talent, energy, and technical skills in the film, video and music industries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa's industrial environment and infrastructure are suitable for use in the film, television, video and music industries;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power vested in me as the Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the Mayor's Film & Music Advisory Board of Tulsa.

SECTION 2. The said Film and Music Advisory Board shall be composed of eleven (11) members, one of whom shall be the Mayor *ex officio* or his/her designated representative, and the other ten (10) members shall be appointed by the Mayor. The terms of five such members shall expire, and those members shall be replaced, each year. The terms of the remaining five members will expire, and those members shall be replaced, every other year.

SECTION 3. The Mayor shall appoint to the Advisory Board persons knowledgeable about the film, television, video and/or music industries, the performing arts, photography and/or the entertainment industry generally. All appointees shall be registered voters of the City of Tulsa. The members of the Advisory Board shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 4. The City of Tulsa Film and Music Advisory Board's mission is to attract and promote film, television, video and music practitioners and companies to do business in Tulsa, and to use Tulsa in film, television, video and music productions.

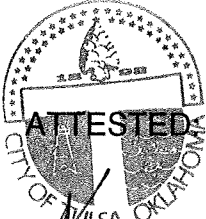
SECTION 5. The Mayor may assign City personnel to assist the Film and Music Advisory Board in its activities. All City departments and personnel are hereby directed to cooperate and assist the said Advisory Board in its efforts.

SECTION 6. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
