EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2011-04

EXCEPTION TO TITLE 6, CHAPTER 4, TRO FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF UNITED STATES HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FUNDED HOUSING PROGRAMS

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this order is to provide for the efficient, timely coordination by the Working In Neighborhoods Department of emergency repairs and housing rehabilitation programs funded by HUD Community Development Block Grants funds and HOME Investment Partnerships Program, and to ensure that the procurement process followed, and the services received by eligible homeowners, are in compliance with HUD's emergency repair and home loan requirements.

Section 2. DIRECTIVE: The Working In Neighborhoods Department shall follow the applicable Federal Rules and Procedures and be exempt from Title 6, Chapter 4 TRO for the contracting of services for the purpose of implementing the HUD's emergency repair and housing rehabilitations programs. The Working In Neighborhoods Department shall follow HUD's procurement procedures pursuant to 24 CFR Part 92 for HOME funds and 24 CFR Part 570 for CDBG funds.

In carrying out the purpose set forth in Section 1 of this order, all HUD funded emergency repair and housing rehabilitation loan programs are subject to monitoring and review by the Department of Grants Administration to ensure that the Working In Neighborhood Department is in compliance with HUD guidelines and requirements.


Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This order shall take effect immediately


