PURPOSE OF THE CLASSIFICATION:

Under general supervision is responsible for performing a variety of unskilled and limited semiskilled tasks; works as a member of a crew engaged in hazardous, heavy construction, and/or major repair or maintenance activities involving City services or facilities, and other related assigned duties.

ESSENTIAL TASKS: (All Department/Divisions):

- Performs unskilled or semi-skilled construction, maintenance and/or repair activities related to water and wastewater operations, facilities and equipment
- Complies with state and federal environmental regulations
- Performs Pretrip inspections and documents condition
- Performs Confined Space Entry (CSE)
- Prepares site protection devices and maintains worksite safety
- Cleans up work area and equipment when the job is completed
- Must report to work on a regular and timely basis

In addition to the above tasks, the following essential tasks may be required by the individual department/division.

<u>SOM</u>

- Protects public health by assisting with the investigation of customer emergency calls to identify and resolve issues
- · Assists with the use of specialized sewer maintenance, mechanical and construction equipment
- Performs sewer mainline repair in excavations

Water Distribution & Water Supply

- Makes repairs to, cleans, disinfects, and flushes the water main systems; and responds to citizen's water quality inquiries
- Inspects, locates, and operates valves and conducts valve surveys by atlas page
- Performs on site credit collection and utility turn-on and offs in some positions
- Maintains grounds, mowing, weed-eating, and building fences in some positions
- Reads, removes, and installs water meters in some positions

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.

QUALIFICATIONS:

<u>Training and Experience:</u> Must meet one of the following options or an equivalent combination of training and experience per Personnel Policies and Procedures, Section 100

- 1. (a) Graduation from high school or possession of a General Educational Development Certificate (GED): **and**,
 - (b) Three (3) months of experience performing heavy manual labor
 - (c) Refer to the Water/Wastewater Works Operator Progression Criterion Document for additional requirements.

- Good knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions of the work
- Good knowledge of the operation and maintenance requirements of trucks and construction equipment
- · Good knowledge of local traffic laws and regulations
- · Good knowledge of the geography and street locations of the city
- Good knowledge of the operation and maintenance of mechanical systems
- Good knowledge of the hazards and applicable safety rules and regulations of equipment operation.

Ability to:

- · Ability to operate trucks and construction equipment skillfully and safely
- · Ability to understand and follow verbal instructions and read and follow written instructions
- · Ability to perform heavy manual labor under any type of weather conditions
- Ability to courteously and tactfully communicate with fellow workers, supervisors, other members of the organization, and the public in giving and receiving information.

Skill in:

• Skill in operating a personal computer and other office machines

<u>Physical Requirements:</u> Physical requirements include frequent walking and standing; frequent lifts/carries up to 60 pounds; occasional lifts/carries up to 105 pounds; occasional pushing and pulling up to 60 pounds; frequent balancing, bending, kneeling, handling, climbing, smelling and twisting; occasional reaching, crawling and feeling; and vision, speech and hearing sufficient to perform the essential tasks.

Licenses and Certificates:

- Possession of a valid Oklahoma Class "D" Driver license
- Possession of a Class "B" Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with applicable endorsements within 6 months from date of hire (some positions)
- Possession of a valid Oklahoma Class "D" Water/Wastewater License as issued by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) within nine (9) months from date of hire.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT: Working environment is primarily outdoors and occasionally indoors, and in inclement weather. May be exposed to the following: hazardous materials, flammable liquids, traffic, cramped work areas, excessive dust, weather/extreme temperatures, trench excavations, underground gas/electric/petroleum lines, rough terrains, cutting/chipping/grinding, hazardous/toxic materials, sewage, damp/wet surfaces, snow/ice covered surfaces, insect bites, poisonous plants, overhead power lines, toxic fumes/vapors/odors, confined spaces, high noises; and may be required to work overtime and be on 24-hour standby.
