SKATENORTH RULES

- Users of this facility assume all risk inherent in the use of this skate park including risk of personal injury or damage to personal property.
- Safety equipment is highly recommended, including helmets, kneepads, elbow pads and wrist guards.
- Children should be supervised by a parent/guardian. Parent/guardian is responsible for the safety and behavior of their children.
- Ramps or obstacles not owned by the City of Tulsa are not allowed in park.
- Graffiti, tagging or stickers prohibited. Vandalism may close the park until repairs are made. This is your park, please protect it from abuse.
- No tobacco, drugs or profanity permitted. Fighting will not be tolerated.
- No scooters, motorized, non-motorized or battery operated riding toys are allowed in park.
- Glass is prohibited.
- Place litter in trash cans. Inspect all surfaces before you ride them. Remove all trash, debris and objects that may prevent a smooth, safe, ride.
- The City of Tulsa reserves the right to revoke use privileges from those who violate any park rules and to close the park without notice for maintenance, repairs, inclement weather and other unforeseeable circumstances.
