Audit Scope and Objectives:	The Office of the City Auditor partnered with City Security and Information Technology management to select an information technology security firm (True Digital Security) for conduct of a VoIP penetration test. The test assessed whether the VoIP system could be accessed externally or internally by unauthorized parties to intercept or decipher calls. The objective was to assess whether security and operational risks have been addressed in the COT VoIP phone system.
Audit Conclusion:	The scope of this testing covered areas of City operations deemed security-sensitive and confidential per Executive Order 2004-01; in accordance with this Order, the results of our testing were communicated only to appropriate management personnel.
